Cozy Fingerless Gloves

Pattern requires the following skills: knitting, seaming with mattress stitch

Yarn

Approximately 50yds of a bulky weight yarn.

Yarn used: A Tree Huggers Wife 'Big One' (100% U.S. merino wool; 175yds/160m per 3.53oz/100g skein)

Needles

5.5 mm/U.S. size 9 knitting needles or needle to obtain gauge.

Notions

Yarn needle.

Gauge

4 sts = 1" in garter stitch.

Finished Measurements

7" length and 6" circumference.

Abbreviations

CO = Cast On k = knit st(s)= stitch(es) rep = repeat

INSTRUCTIONS

(make 2)

Cast On 27sts.

Row 1: knit all sts



Rep row 1 until piece measures 6" from Cast On edge. Bind off and make one more piece.

Seam rectangle 1 1/2" from one side and 2 1/2" from the opposite side.

You should now have 2 cozy fingerless mitts.
