Cozy Cowl

Pattern requires the following skills: knitting

Yarn

Approximately 150yds of a bulky weight yarn.

Yarn used: A Tree Huggers Wife 'Big One' (100% U.S. merino wool; 175yds/160m per 3.53oz/100g skein)

Needles

6.5 mm/U.S. size 10.5 24" circular knitting needles or needle to obtain gauge.

Notions

Yarn needle.

Gauge

12 sts = 4" (10cm) in stockinette stitch.

Finished Measurements

23" circumference and 11" in depth.

Abbreviations

CO = Cast On

k = knit

st(s)= stitch(es)

rep = repeat

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast On 90sts and join in the round, careful not to twist.

Round 1: knit all sts

Rep round 1 until piece measures 10" from CO edge. Bind off and block your piece.

All finished!



This simple 'knit in the round' cowl pattern is a great first project for those wanting to learn how to knit.
